

The Epistle on Legal Theory (Library of Arabic Literature)



The Epistle on Legal Theory is the oldest surviving Arabic work on Islamic legal theory and the foundational document of Islamic jurisprudence. Its author, Muhammad ibn Idris al-Shafi'i, is a central figure in the development of Islamic law. The work is a translation of his Risalah, a treatise on legal theory. The translation by Joseph E. Lowry is part of the Library of Arabic Literature series, published by Columbia University Press. The book is available in both print and digital formats. The print edition is a hardcover, 8vo, 8" x 9" tall, with pp. The digital edition is available as a PDF file. The book is a valuable resource for scholars and students of Islamic law and history.
